- Placement into PHYS 1010, when taught on the high school campus, can occur without a CPT score by completing any CE or high school Biology or Chemistry course with lab.
- Placement into PHYS 1010 can occur without a CPT score by completing MATH 1010 with a "C" grade or higher.
- Placement into PHYS 1210 can occur without a CPT score by completing MATH 1060 or MATH 1080 with "C" grade or higher.

- Students must have taken Secondary Mathematics 1, 2 & 3 to qualify to take any CE Math class
- MATH 1010 does not meet college GE Math requirements for a degree, but rather, is a prerequisite option for students with low CPT scores to qualify for higher GE Math courses.
- Placement into MATH 1010, MATH 1030 or MATH 1040 can occur without a CPT score by completing Secondary Math 1, 2 & 3 with a “C” average or better in each.
- Placement into MATH 1050 can occur without a CPT score by completing MATH 1010 with “C” grade or higher.
- Placement into MATH 1060 or MATH 1080 can occur without a CPT score by completing MATH 1050 with a “C” grade or higher.
- MATH 1060 is recommended to students who complete MATH 1050, while MATH 1080 is recommended for students who skip/test-out of MATH 1050 and who took Honors Secondary Math 1, 2 & 3.
- It is not recommended that students “test-in” to MATH 1210, but rather qualify by taking MATH 1080 or by taking MATH 1050 & 1060.
- All college-level math classes taken after high school graduation, require a qualifying CPT score.
